- Chris Huhne, the Secretary of State for Energy and Climate Change, has asked Dr Mike Weightman to provide a report to the Government on the

implications of the unprecedented events in Japan and the lessons to be learned for the UK nuclear industry.

- He has asked for an interim report by mid May 2011 and a final report within six months. The reports will be made public.
- The detail of Mike Weightman's report will be established shortly. The report will be conducted in close cooperation with the IAEA (International Atomic Energy Agency) Japan, and other international regulators to carefully establish what lessons can be learned.

Subject: Horizon Updated Position

Hi both,

For information, please see below an updated Horizon public position regarding the ongoing events in Japan.

- Following the devastating earthquake and tsunami in Japan, our heart-felt sympathy goes out to all those who have been affected.
- The nuclear incidents which are currently taking place in Japan are still unfolding and it would not be appropriate for us to comment given that we do not have first hand involvement.
- However we welcome the announcement by the Secretary of State for Energy and Climate Change, Chris Huhne, that the Chief Nuclear Inspector, Dr Mike Weightman, will prepare a report on the implications and lessons learned from the situation in Japan.
- The Weightman report will be crucial to learning lessons from events in Japan, and we regard it with the utmost importance. It is essential that the right time is taken, to validate safety standards for existing and future nuclear stations and learn lessons from events in Japan. We will continue to develop our proposals but we will take full account of the results of the Weightman report to help guide our ongoing work.
- UK nuclear installations are built with a wealth of safety measures in place to ensure that they can withstand a range of natural disasters and avoid causing harm to the public or to the environment. These installations are assessed extremely thoroughly by the regulators to ensure that containment remains effective even in the most extreme circumstances, and the design that Horizon selects for its proposed installations will also go through this thorough assessment.
